FATHER KNOWS BEST... What are Indulgences?



We believe that when we repent from our sins, God in his love and mercy forgives us. However, every offense, even after being forgiven, entails an unhealthy attachment to creatures and requires a certain amount of reparation. These are called 'temporal punishments' which must be purified either here on earth, or after death in the state called Purgatory.

A biblical example illustrating this can be found in David's repentance: "And Nathan said to David, 'The Lord also has put away your sin; you shall not die. Nevertheless, because by this deed you have utterly scorned the Lord, the child who is born to you shall die.'" (2 Sam 12:13-14) God forgave David from the guilt of his sin, but he still had to suffer the loss of his son as well as other temporal consequences to atone for his sin. Even on a human level, for example, if I damage someone else's property, I can sincerely ask for forgiveness and they may wholeheartedly forgive me; nonetheless, I will also have to pay for the repair of the damaged property or compensate them in one way or another.

Thus, in order to help us expiate these temporal punishments on earth, **the Church offers repentant sinners the possibility of shortening their penances through certain pious or charitable acts and conditions** that also promote their spiritual life and devotion... And that is what an indulgence is!

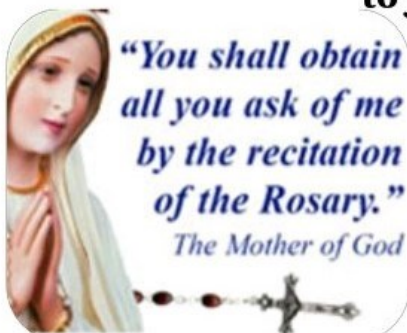
