

"God sent his only Son from the heavens to the earth as the Light for all the world. God's Word has hid himself in the Virgin Mary's womb, and from her he took his flesh. His star was seen on high, shining brightly in the East, as foretold in Balaam's words. Wise men, led by the star to the place where Jesus lay, honored him with finest gifts." Stanza 1 of God Sent (Arsal Allah)

This is the first stanza of a special hymn we sing during the Christmas Novena. We hear in this hymn the plan and story of Jesus' birth and how God sent his Son as a Light for all the world. There are times when we lose our focus on the Light and get caught up in the darkness of our world. It is almost effortless to go down the path of reflecting on the darkness of our pain, our suffering, our sickness, and death. Not only do we sometimes dwell on it, it seems that wherever we look we are bombarded by it in our society that is infatuated with the darkness. What is the remedy? How do we combat this tendency? Who can help us?

God sent his only Son from the heavens to the earth as the Light for all the world. Light in all religions has always been a symbol of illumination, clarity, knowledge, wisdom, intelligence, and the divine. In the Bible, light is a symbol of holiness, goodness, grace, hope, knowledge, wisdom. In the Gospel of John 1:4-9, "In him (Jesus) was light, and that life was the light of all mankind. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it. There was a man sent from God whose name was John. He came as a witness to testify concerning that light, so that through him all might believe. He himself was not the light; he came only as a witness to the light."

Have you ever noticed Christmas decorations without lights? The trees are dimmer, the houses are dark, the wreaths are nice but missing something. It is only when they are covered in lights do, we really feel the spirit of Christmas. The way the lights sparkle and twinkle during this time brings a cheer and joy that can be felt in our hearts. Christmas is not just a time for lights, it is the time of the Light, Jesus Christ. Do we feel that? Are we missing that sparkle and twinkles in our hearts? Do we want to let His Light enter into our darkness to allow our lives to shine brighter, to sparkle a little more? Yes? That's wonderful! No? Why not? What are we afraid of? Jesus comes to us as a child, so that we may understand that is how He sees us. He comes to share with us His light, a light so powerful that all the darkness in the world can never extinguish. He offers this as a gift that we may receive Him and know that He is with us. In our dark times, shining as a beacon of hope, and our bright times as the one who makes them sparkle more gloriously than we can imagine.

The Wise Men were wise because they found the brightest star and followed it. They understood that they needed to follow the light of the highest star to find the true Light who lifts us to the heights of Heaven. This is the story of Christmas. That the Light of our Lord, Jesus Christ, is shared with you and me. The Light of our Lord is a gift that enlightens our souls and can never be extinguished. This light grows ever brighter when we share His Light with those around us.

Wishing you a Christmas filled with light, hope, peace, and love.
